

Camera-Ready Instructions Poster Track FAIEMA 2026

4th International Conference on Frontiers of Artificial Intelligence, Ethics, and Multidisciplinary Applications L'Aquila, Italy | 9–11 September 2026

Accepted Poster Track submissions will **not** be included in the Springer conference proceedings.

1. Poster Design Requirements

You must prepare a **large-format conference poster** (single page).

- **Size: A1** (594 mm × 841 mm)
- **Orientation:** Either **portrait** or **landscape** is acceptable. Portrait is more common, but choose whichever best suits your content layout.
- The poster should be visually engaging and clearly communicate:
 - Title and authors (with affiliations)
 - Research problem / objectives
 - Methodology
 - Key results / findings (use figures, graphs, tables)
 - Conclusions and future work
 - Contact information / QR code (optional)

Design tips: Use large, readable fonts (for body text when printed), high-resolution images, and a clean layout readable from 1–2 meters away.

2. File to Upload (Camera-Ready)

Upload **only one file**:

1. **Camera-ready poster (PDF)** – high-quality PDF of your final A1 poster design.

3. How to Upload in EasyChair

1. Log in to EasyChair with the **Author** role.
2. Go to your accepted submission → **View** → **Add or upload files**.
3. Upload the poster PDF as Camera Ready (recommended filename: PaperID_Poster.pdf).

4. At the Conference

- **Print the physical A1 poster** and bring it with you to L'Aquila.
- Posters will be presented in a dedicated poster session.
- At least one author must be present at the poster to discuss the work.
- Detailed mounting instructions and session schedule will be provided later.

5. Registration

At least one author must register under the **Poster Track** rate. Details will follow.
